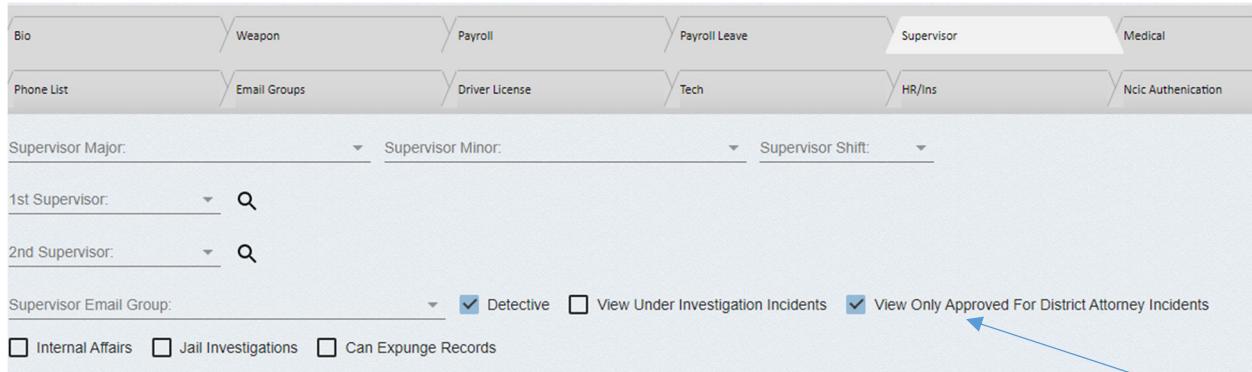


I have modified our employee security and added the following Checkbox for

View Only Approved For District Attorney Incidents. It has to be applied to each Employee that would have this Firm Filter. Meaning if this is checked there is no way to lookup any other incident report in your system by this person (period). It's a hard filter on any lookup or Incident List. Statistics reports do not have this filter as there is no detail about the case/incident.



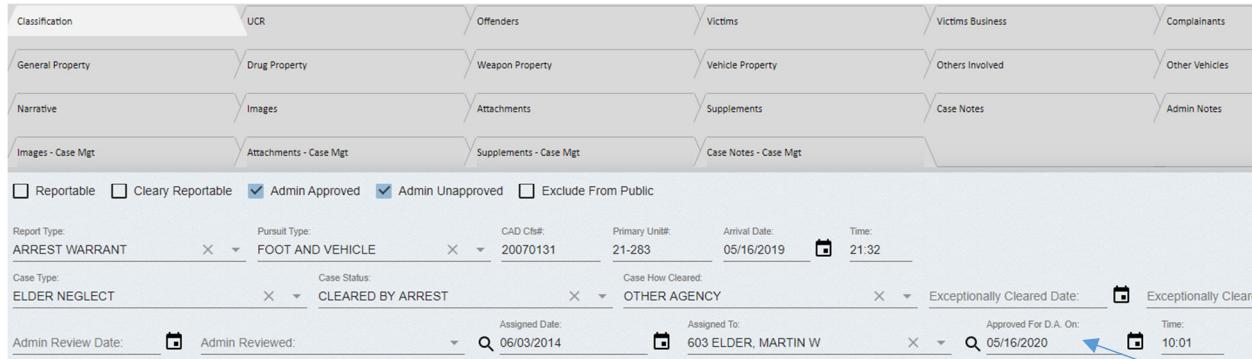

How to use it.

In iSoms Incidents on the 1<sup>st</sup> tab to the right of Assigned to Officer is a Date/Time for Approved D.A. On.

"IF" this date is populated that is what the filter is based on.

This is a hard filter. So when that employee, with the check box, logs in and opens incident, no matter what the other filters they narrow by Date, Employee, Street it will always hard filter on this date being populated. Only reports with that date populated will be displayed.
