

## Revised Estimated Release Date Calculation

iSOMS now computes the estimated release date in hours. There is no longer an override time for release date as we are now computing it. We only compute whole hour's not partial hours.

The example below is very limited just to show the basics

My example:

Intake date: 11/01/2014 17:33

Sentence Start Date: 07/22/2020 08:00

County Hours to Serve: 5

Credit Hours Custody: 1

If no sentence days or hours (no computation)

If Sentence Days greater than 0 or Sentence Hours greater than 0 it will process

If Sentence Start Date/Time is empty it will use Intake Date/Time (otherwise it uses Sentence Start)

07/22/2020 0800 + 5 hours to serve – 1 hour credit = release at 07/22/2020 12:00

Full computation

Note: Percent to Serve. **0%** and **100%** are **the same** meaning to serve 100% of time.

State Days \* 24(hours) = Total State Hours to Serve

Total State Hours \* Percent to Serve

County Days \* 24(hours) + County Hours = Total County Days to Hours to Serve

Total County Hours \* Percent to Serve

Total hours to Serve = Total State Hours to Serve + Total County Hours to Serve

Minus Credits

Total Credit Hours = Credit Behavior Days \* 24(hours)

Total Credit Hours = (above hours) + Credit Days in Custody Days \* 24(hours)

Total Credit Hours = (above hours) + Credit Hours in Custody

Net Hours to Serve = Total Hours to Serve – Total Credit Hours

Release Date = Sentence Start Date + Net Hours (note if sentence start is empty it used Intake date)
